The Northern Virginia North-South Corridor Master Plan Study, underway since May 2012, is now completing the evaluation of transportation options that connect major centers of activity within the study area. The Northern Virginia North-South Corridor has been designated a Corridor of Statewide Significance by the Commonwealth Transportation Board.

The study team will share evaluation results of the transportation alternatives and preliminary recommendations. The alternatives will address access to major activity areas, transit service and nonmotorized modes of travel, environmental considerations, and transportation funding and investments within the corridor.
