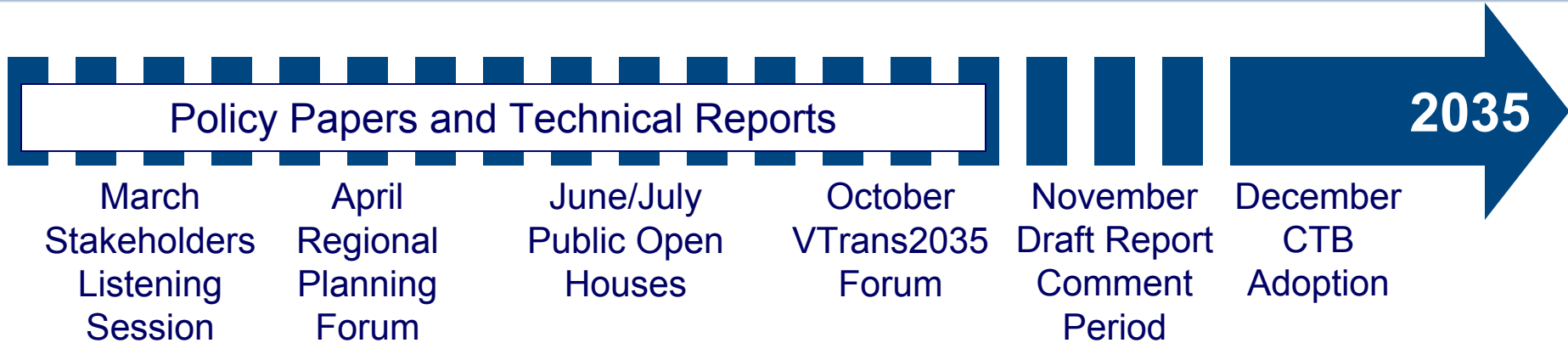

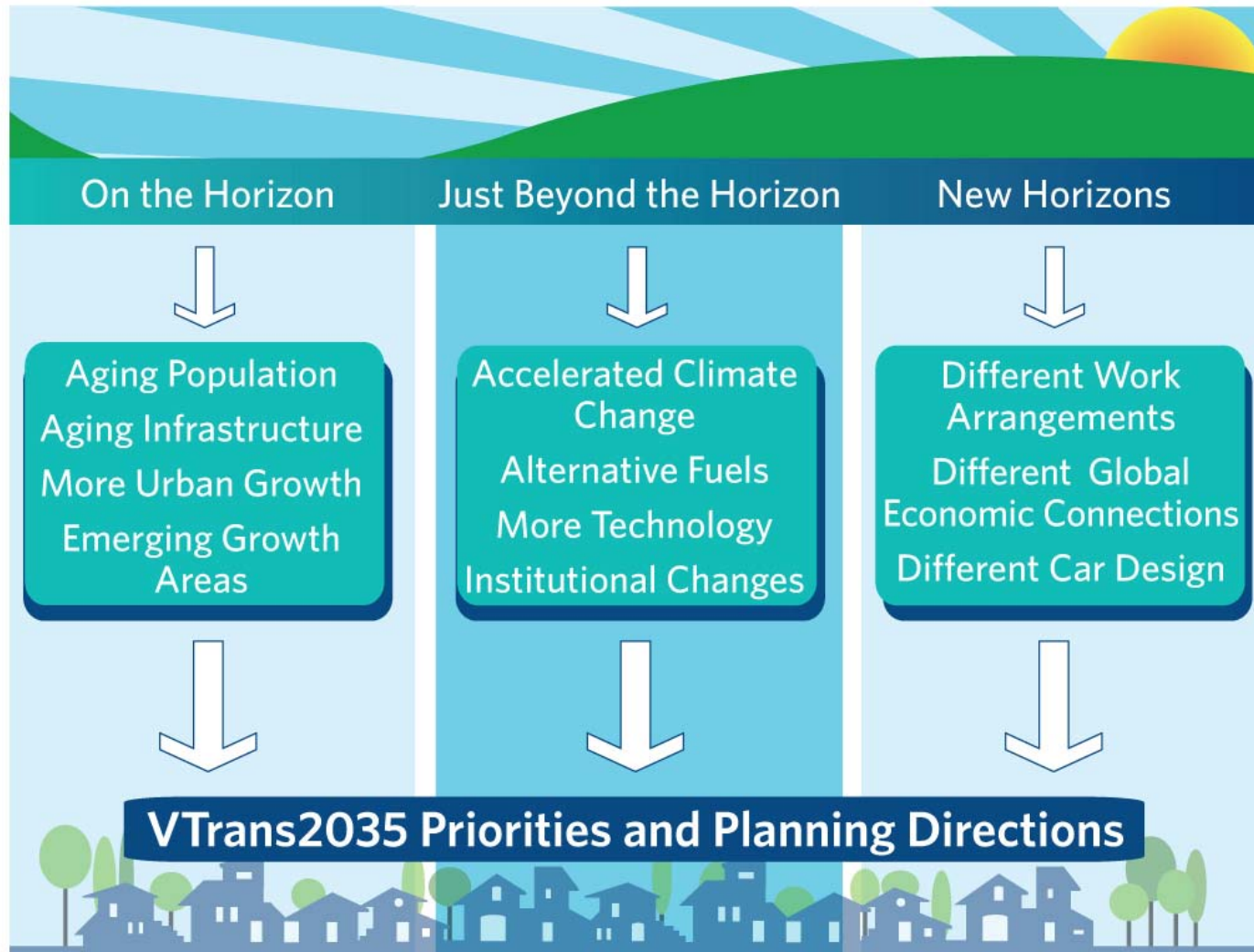

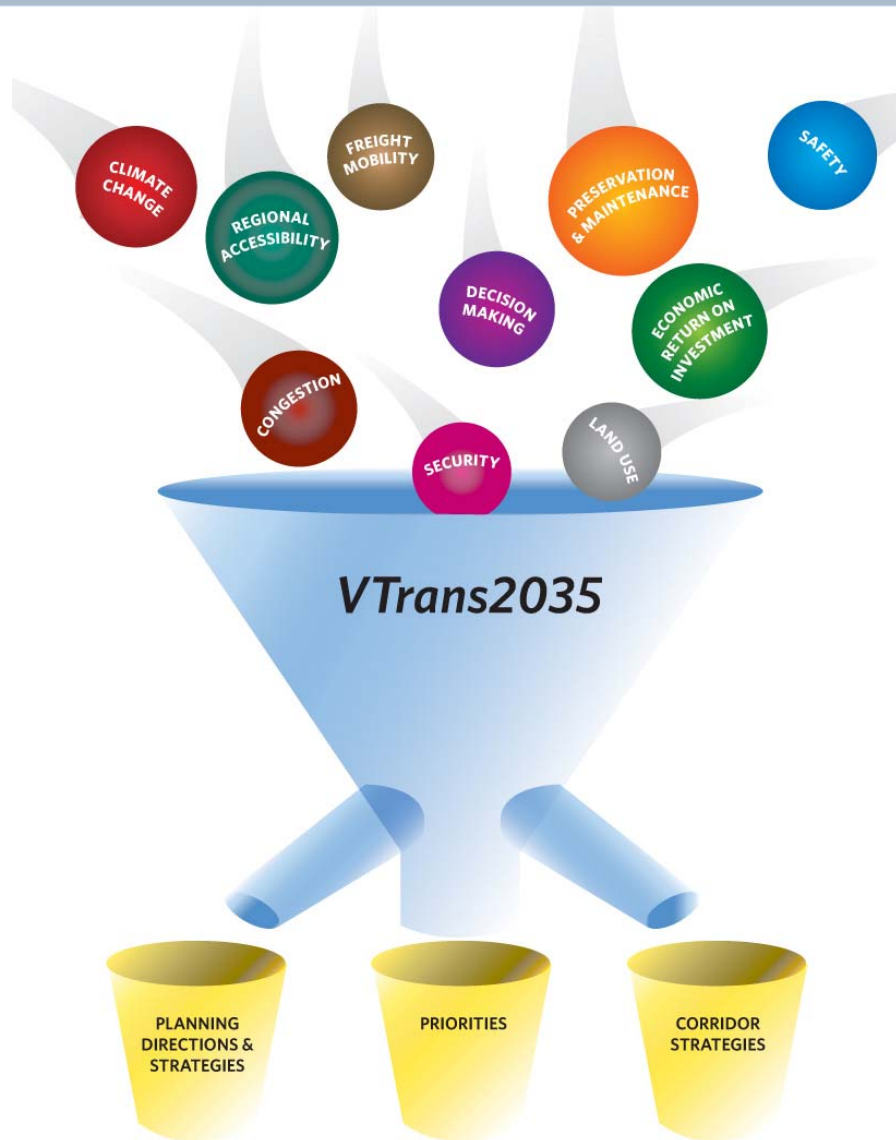

- Continued investment in pavement, bridges, and transit fleets
- Fund security initiatives related to freight rail carriers transporting security-sensitive or hazardous materials
- Expand freight rail network

- Invest in high speed and intercity rail
- Expand Travel Demand Management
- Develop incentives for TOD and improved regional accessibility
- Expand use of value pricing
- Increase use of alternative fuels
- Promote multi-agency resource involvement
- Provide technical assistance to comprehensive plans and zoning ordinances
